## Field Trip Reminder - Post it on the Fridge!

### The Field Museum - Chicago

#### Student Information:

- Our field trip will be **Wednesday, May 30th** to The Field Museum in Chicago.
- Students arriving after 8 AM may not be able to participate.
- Students will need a sack lunch packed in disposable containers. **(NO GLASS!)**
- The Student Code of Conduct will be enforced throughout the trip.
- Uniforms are required. Students who arrive at school not in uniform may not be able to attend.
- Students may **NOT** bring electronics. This includes Ipods, smart watches, cell phones, and game systems. Students may bring an actual camera, as long as it is a camera and **NOT** a cell phone with a camera.
- Students may bring a small bag to keep on the bus to hold a bus snack (*drinks with lids only - nothing messy*) or a book to read.
- Plan to pick up your child by **5:00** on the **WEST** side of LaSalle (bus lot).
  - Students not picked up by 5:20 will be put on an activity bus.

#### Chaperone Information:

- Upon arrival to school, please park in the staff lot at front entrance, or **EAST** lot where car riders are dropped off in the morning. *Cars parked in the rear lot will block the buses and may be towed.*
- Please arrive at your child's classroom no later than **8:00 a.m.**
- You will need to bring a sack lunch that is completely disposable and contains no glass.
- Bring a watch or cell phone if possible.
- Chaperones are asked not to provide their son/daughter with access to electronics, as students are not to use electronics on the trip.

#### IMPORTANT:

- 1) We have room for 6 chaperones per 5th-grade classroom.
- 2) **ALL chaperones MUST have a submitted and approved background check on file with the school.**
- 3) Please indicate if your student needs to have a school sack lunch provided.
- 4) Students who routinely take medication at the nurse's office during the day will have a dosage sent on the trip to take.

## The Field Museum Itinerary

Wednesday, May 30, 2018

### 8:00 AM to 10:00 AM Eastern time (7:00 AM to 9:00 AM Central time):

- students and chaperones load the buses
- travel to Chicago (to EAST entrance of the museum)
- students and chaperones disembark and gather in the lobby for instructions

### 10:00 AM - 11:45 PM Eastern time (9:00 AM - 10:45 AM Central Time)

- Students and chaperones visit museum exhibits

### 11:45 PM to 12:15 PM E.T. (10:45 AM to 11:15 AM C.T.)

- Students and chaperones eat in the **Siragusa Lunchroom**, which is located in the center area on the **Ground floor**.

### 12:15 PM to 2:30 PM E.T. (11:15 to 1:30 C.T.)

- Students and chaperones visit museum exhibits

### 2:30 PM to 3:00 PM E.T. (1:30 to 2:00 C.T.)

- Students and chaperones gather in lobby.
- Students and chaperones board the buses.

### 3:00 PM to between 4:30 and 5:00 PM E.T. (2:00 PM E.T.)

- Return trip to South Bend, Indiana

### Between 4:30 & 5:00 PM

- Students are picked up at LaSalle in the East, or front, parking lot.
  - Any students not picked up by 5:20 PM will be put on an activity bus. These buses are in the West lot, in the back of the building.

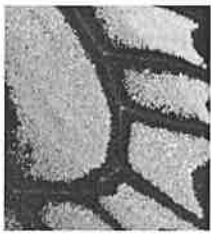
